Highlights of *The Green Collection* include:

- The Codex Climaci Rescriptus, earliest surviving New Testament
- Cuneiform tablets

- Jewish scrolls, spanning more than 700 years of history
- Biblical and classical papyri, including texts dating back to the time of the now-lost Library of Alexandria
- Rare illuminated manuscripts
- Artifacts and manuscripts documenting the history of the King James Bible
