

# How to use a concordance

Learn how to use a strong's concordance to enrich your bible studies.

## Instructions

Things you'll need:

- A Bible
  - An exhaustive concordance
1. Open up your concordance. It is made up of three sections:
    1. Main Concordance
    2. Hebrew Dictionary - Old testament
    3. Greek Dictionary - New testament
  
  2. Select a word from your bible.
  
  3. Look that word up in the main concordance.  
You will find all the biblical references of that word in the bible.
  
  4. Select a biblical reference and read the number to the right of the reference.  
This is the number you need for the dictionaries.
  
  5. If the reference is from the Old Testament go to the Hebrew dictionary.  
If the reference is from the New Testament go to the Greek dictionary.
  
  6. Look up the number and you will get:
    1. the original Hebrew or Greek word
    2. An explanation of that word
    3. Other words the original Hebrew or Greek word has been translated into.
- Lastly enjoy your bible studies.

# How to use biblestudytools.com

## Instructions

Things you'll need:

- computer

1. Go to the website [biblestudytools.com](http://biblestudytools.com)
2. Type in the verse reference that you want to study in the search the bible box.
3. When the verse shows up, change the bible version to New American Standard and click the boxes labeled "Strong's Numbers" and Cross references.
4. Click on any word in blue to see the word in its original language along with its definition. To the right you will see a column of all other places that this same word is used. You can click on them to be redirected to those verses.
5. To see cross referenced verses click on the number that are highlighted in the verses.
6. You can do a lot of things on this website. When you have some available time look around and see what you can discover!
